


paysage>paysages is an original event carried by the Department of Isère, on an artistic proposal of LABORATORY.

paysage>paysages is presented on all 7431 km2 of the department during 3 months, the time of a season. The first edition was presented during the fall of 2016: from September 21st to December 20th, and the next ones will take place during the winter: from December 21st, 2017 to March 20th, 2018; Spring: March 21 to June 20, 2019; Summer: June 21 to September 20, 2020.

**paysage>paysages** is a program composed by a multitude of actors from culture, heritage, nature, spatial planning, education, research, higher education, mobility, tourism, ....

Drawing on the obvious qualities of the landscapes of Isère, our goal is to develop and share a new territorial imaginary. Because in a time of globalization amplifying technical standardization and the standardization of lifestyles, specificities remain that are neither tensions of identity, nor memorial traces. It is our trajectories in this particular environment that form heritage and we want to explore the story.

By associating innovative artistic initiatives with collaborative and fun forms open to the greatest number, **paysage>paysages** wishes to make our territory comfortable and explicit, to generate new representations, to translate unknown uses, to anticipate practices, to make this territory a common good shared among all, native of here or heirs of other landscapes.
